

## Press release: Signing of the Grant Contract for the project ROMD00074 – FLOOD RESCUE

### *“Joint preparedness for rescue lives from floods”*

On July 14, 2025 we signed the grant contract of ROMD00074 – FLOOD RESCUE “Joint preparedness for rescue lives from floods” project.

The project is financed by the European Union through Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (NDICI), through Interreg NEXT Romania-Republic of Moldova 2021-2027, Programme Priority 1 – Green Communities, Specific objective 1.1 - Promoting climate change adaptation and disaster risk prevention, resilience, taking into account eco-system based approaches.

The project general objective consists in increasing the protection of the population against floods in the eligible area by improving and enhancing the training and intervention capacity for floods of professional firefighters from both sides of the border through endowment with equipment for interventions and organizing joint trainings.

The project partnership is formed by the following institutions from Romania and Republic of Moldova:

- Lead Partner: General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations from Romania;
- Partner 2: “Nicolae Iorga” Inspectorate for Emergency Situations of Botoşani County;
- Partner 3: General Inspectorate of Aviation of the Ministry of Internal Affairs;
- Partner 4: Regional department for search and rescue nr.2 of General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations of Republic of Moldova.

The implementation period of the project is **15.07.2025 – 14.07.2027**.





**The total budget of the project is 1.664.682,42 Euro, of which non-reimbursable financing 1.498.214,15 Euro.**

The project addresses the cross-border area between Romania and Republic of Moldova, with the following **results**:

- 1 updated common procedure for intervention in case of floods;
- 4 joint training sessions organized;
- increased training capacity through the procurement of intervention equipment;
- increased operational capacity in the eligible area through the purchase of special intervention vehicles.

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
