



Press Release: Signing of the Financing Contract for Project ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO-MD Cross-border Area”

On July 10, 2025, the financing contract was signed for project ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO-MD Cross-border Area.”

The project is funded by the European Union through the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (NDICI), under the Interreg NEXT Romania–Republic of Moldova Programme 2021–2027, Priority 1 – Green Communities, Specific Objective 1.1 – Promoting climate change adaptation, disaster risk prevention and resilience, taking into account ecosystem-based approaches.

The general objective of the project is to increase the protection of the population against floods in the eligible area by improving and strengthening the preparedness and intervention capacity of professional firefighters on both sides of the border, through the provision of intervention equipment and the organization of joint training sessions.

The project partnership includes one institution from Romania and one from the Republic of Moldova, as follows:

- Lead Partner: “Nicolae Iorga” Emergency Situations Inspectorate of Botoşani County;
- Partner 2: Exceptional Situations Directorate of Bălţi Municipality, General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations of the Republic of Moldova.

The project implementation period is from 10.07.2025 to 10.01.2027.

The total project budget amounts to 322,648.20 EUR, of which 290,383.37 EUR is non-reimbursable funding.

The project targets the cross-border area between Romania and the Republic of Moldova and aims to deliver the following results:

- One updated joint procedure for flood intervention;
- Increased preparedness capacity through the acquisition of intervention equipment;
- Enhanced operational capacity in the eligible area through the purchase of intervention vehicles;
- Organization and implementation of flood prevention campaigns.
