## **Press release: Signing of the Grant Contract for the project ROMD00073 – EnIS “Enhancing the intervention skills of professional firefighters”**

Today, 22.08.2025, we signed the grant contract of ROMD00073 – EnIS “Enhancing the intervention skills of professional firefighters” project.

The project is financed by the European Union through Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (NDICI), through **Interreg NEXT Romania-Republic of Moldova 2021-2027**, Programme Priority 1 – Green Communities, Specific objective 1.1 - Promoting climate change adaptation and disaster risk prevention, resilience, taking into account eco-system based approaches.

**The project general objective** consists in supporting the joint response to the emergency situation in the cross-border area, through the organization of a joint exercise and the acquisition of specialized equipment to increase the resilience of intervention capacities for the protection of material goods and cultural heritage values, while ensuring the survival of affected populations and the safety of citizens in case of emergencies.

- 1 updated common procedure for responding to emergencies/disasters/exceptional situations and emergency medical assistance;
- 1 common training exercise;
- increasing training capacity by purchasing intervention equipment;
- increasing the operational capacity in the eligible area through the purchase of emergency vehicles.
