

Press Release: Conduct of Workshop No. 4 for the Development of Information and Preventive Education Materials within the Flood Risk Awareness Campaign under Project ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO–MD Cross-border Area”

During the period of May 12–15, 2026, the 4th workshop organized by the Emergency Situations Directorate of Bălți Municipality was held within the framework of the Emergency Situations Directorate of Bălți Municipality, Republic of Moldova, acting as a partner together with representatives of the “Nicolae Iorga” Inspectorate for Emergency Situations of Botoșani County, Romania – the project leader, under the project “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO–MD Cross-Border Area – ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS”, implemented through the Interreg NEXT Romania–Republic of Moldova 2021–2027 Programme.

The workshop activities focused on the development of promotional and informational-educational materials regarding flood risk prevention and reduction.

During the mentioned period, the activities carried out and the progress achieved within the first three workshops were presented, during which the foundations for the development of the tools and procedures targeted by the project were established. Within Workshop No. 4, draft versions of the informational-educational materials were developed, including: the operational NOTEBOOK, the questionnaire-type FLYER, the calendar POSTER, and the informational BROCHURE, all aimed at informing and raising public awareness regarding the risks associated with floods.

The workshop organized during this period represented an important opportunity for strengthening cooperation between the partners and facilitating a valuable exchange of best practices. The expertise of specialists from both countries was effectively combined in the process of creating modern communication and information tools, which will genuinely contribute to increasing public awareness regarding flood risks, prevention measures, and appropriate behavior in emergency situations.
