

Press Release: Organization of the 3rd Steering Committee within the ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS Project “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO-MD Cross-border Area”

During 25–27 May 2026, in the municipality of Botoșani, Romania, the third Steering Committee was held, organized by the “Nicolae Iorga” Emergency Situations Inspectorate of Botoșani County, Romania – lead partner of the project, together with representatives of the Emergency Situations Directorate of Bălți Municipality, acting as partner within the project “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO–MD Cross-border Area” – ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS, financed through the Interreg NEXT Romania–Republic of Moldova Programme 2021–2027.

During the meeting, the analysis of the implementation status of activities and deliverables was presented, along with the updated implementation plan, the status of expenditures incurred during reporting periods 1, 2, and 3, as well as the expenditures forecasted for reporting periods 4 and 5 of the project. Discussions also covered activities related to budget execution, the initiation, organization, and completion of public procurement procedures, as well as the measures planned for periods 4 and 5.

In addition, other topics regarding the status of Partner Report No. 2 were addressed, together with the continuous assurance of the project’s visibility.
