Workshop No. 1 for Drafting training curriculum within the Project ROMD00024 – C-TRAINED „Cross Border Joint Training”

The Căușeni Regional Directorate for Emergency Situations continues the implementation of the planned activities within the Project ROMD00024.

Thus, during 20–24 april 2026, in Iași Municipality, Romania, Workshop No. 1 for Drafting training curriculum within the Project ROMD00024 – C-TRAINED „Cross Border Joint Training”.

The development of the training agenda for firefighters from Romania and the Republic of Moldova aims to improve the efficiency of intervention activities for the partners involved in the project, strengthen response methods, and facilitate the exchange of techniques during the firefighting phase in residential areas.

The Căușeni Regional Directorate for Emergency Situations of the General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova, participates as Partner No. 2 in the Project ROMD00024 – C-TRAINED – Cross-Border Joint Training, within the Interreg VI-B NEXT Romania–Republic of Moldova Programme, funded by the European Commission and, through financial contribution, by the Government of the Republic of Moldova.

The total value of the project is EUR 1,593,354.95, while the amount allocated to the General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations of the Republic of Moldova – Căușeni Regional Directorate for Emergency Situations within this project is EUR 712,693.28.

The project duration is 24 months: 15 July 2025 – 14 July 2027.

The specific objective of the project is to promote climate change adaptation, disaster risk prevention, and resilience, taking into account ecosystem-based approaches.

The general objective is to improve the joint response to emergency situations in the cross-border area through the organization of joint training courses and the procurement of specialized intervention equipment.

Results:

- ✓ 1 updated joint procedure for the management and efficient implementation of joint interventions;
- ✓ 12 joint training sessions organized, with a total of 144 firefighters trained (72 from Romania and 72 from DRSE Căușeni);

- ✓ Increased training capacity through the procurement of equipment for training and intervention activities;
- ✓ Enhanced operational capacity in the eligible area through the procurement of specialized emergency response vehicles;
- ✓ Equipment procured: 1 wildland firefighting intervention vehicle with increased traction, 1 minibus intervention vehicle with a capacity of 7+1 seats and increased traction, 2 vehicles with increased traction.
