

Press Release: Conduct of Workshop No. 3 for the Development of Information and Preventive Education Materials within the Flood Risk Awareness Campaign under Project ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO–MD Cross-border Area”

Between April 21–24, 2026, the third workshop was held at the General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations “Nicolae Iorga” of Botoșani County, Romania. The event was organized by ISU Botoșani, Romania – the project leader – together with representatives of the Emergency Situations Directorate of Bălți Municipality, acting as project partner, for the development of promotional materials on flood prevention within the project “Enhancing Community Resilience in the RO–MD Cross-border Area – ROMD00183 – FLOODWALLS,” implemented under the Interreg NEXT Romania–Republic of Moldova 2021–2027 Programme.

During this period, the activities and progress achieved in the first two workshops were presented, which laid the foundation for the development of the tools and procedures addressed. Within Workshop No. 3, draft versions of the following information and educational materials were developed:



1. **Operational Notebook** – prevention, preparedness, and flood management for local public authorities, A6 format;
2. **Flyer–Questionnaire**, A4 format, intended for adolescents and adults;
3. **Poster–Calendar**, A3 format, containing preventive advice and recommended behavior before a flood event, adapted for each month of the year;
4. **Brochure**: “*Mira and the Firefighter Grandfather – Adventures Among Raindrops*”, A format, intended for preschool children and pupils up to 8 years old, featuring an educational story designed to promote preventive behavior among children.

The workshop held during this period provided partners with the opportunity to exchange best practices, combining the expertise of specialists from both countries with the development of effective communication tools that will contribute significantly to raising awareness of flood risks.

The next workshop, aimed at finalizing the informational materials, is scheduled to take place between May 12–15, 2026, at the Emergency Situations Directorate of Bălți Municipality, Republic of Moldova.
